- 12 pairs shoes
- 1 lot of Casting
- 36 gun locks
- 8 great Coats
- 1 piece broad
- 2 pieces beudanas inkert
- 2 barrels of Salt
- 135 yds Cheek in thread
- 1 barrel tobacco
