Ball as Park City Arkansas

January 7th 1861

To his Excellency

Henry M Rector Governor of

Sir - there was an election held in
this county on the 29th day of
December 1860 for the purpose of
electing officers for the 49th
Regiment Arkansas militia
and resulted as follows

William H Earp was elected
Lieutenant Col and Joseph ~~Oliver~~

- Mr Oliver was elected Major

and John Ashford was elected
captain and Lewis McGroom first
Lieutenant and Mr A Frost
second Lieutenant of company
E 49th Rgmt of all of whom I hope
you will commission as soon
as convenient
