Dear sir:-


I have the roster of Company "D" First Arkansas Cavalry Volunteers, which would like to submit for publication if it is agreeable to the Historical Association.

Am endeavoring to bring the matter down to the First of January 1908, by this I am trying to get the ~~date~~ of death of all those who have passed away since the war, and give the present residence of all the members of this company now living.

The report of the Adj General of 1868 is very scarce and as you remember only a few thousand were printed, and that by the U.S., since Arkansas would not condescend to get out a report of the Union Soldiers, their campaigns etc.

If you will kindly let me know about this I will immediately upon receipt of your letter set about gathering the material last mentioned.
