# JAMES MILLER,

## GOVERNOR OF THE TERRITORY OF ARKANSAS,

TO ALL WHO SHALL SEE THESE PRESENTS----GREETING:

KNOW YE, That reposing special trust and confidence in the integrity and abilities of *Jacob Miller* I have hereby appointed him a *Sheriff* *with*  
*and for the County of Crawford in said Territory*

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the advantages and emoluments ~~appertaining~~ <sup>two</sup> to said office, for the term of <sup>two</sup> four years, unless sooner removed

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have herunto set my hand, and caused the seal of the Territory to be affixed, this *18th* day of *Jan'y* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-*one* and in the forty-*fifth* year of the Independence of the United States.
