with General Order No. 31, Paragraph No.  
4 dated, Vicksburg Miss. Sept. 26<sup>th</sup> 1867  
We have the honor to hand you a list  
of Erased names - whom we find to  
be disqualified, under the additional  
Supplementary act, with the charges  
prepared set opposite their names.  
All those marked "violation of oath" did  
afterwards engage in the rebellion.  
All marked "officer" or "officer holder"  
did afterwards engage in the rebellion.  
Those marked "Not Citizens" are men  
from other States, who are disqualif-  
ied there etc. Also we hand you  
a list of names added to the
