of their Discharge to Enable them to receive their Pay &c.

I certify, on honor, that Cleazer Lemaster a Private
of Capt Hugo L B Potofuhr Company B of the first Regiment
of Cavalry Volunteers of the State of Arkansas born in Johnson
County Kentucky aged 41 years 3 feet 6 inches high fair Complexion
Blue Eyes light hair and by Occupation a Farmer was Enrolled
or Enlisted at Washington County Arkansas and Mustered in
Service by Lt. Col. Mills at Springfield Mo. on the first day
of August 1862 to serve in the Regiment for the term of three
years; and having Served honestly and faithfully with his
Company in Mo. & Ark Geo to the present date. is now Entitled
to a Discharge by reason of

A Surgeon Certificate of Disability

The said Cleazer Lemaster was last paid by paymaster Maj D. Bishop
to include the 30th day of April 1863 and has pay due him from that time
to the present date. and he is entitled to pay and Subsistences for
traveling to place of Enrolment and whatever other allowances are
authorized to Volunteer Soldiers. or Militia. so discharged
He has received Clothing from the United States, not paid for, amounting
to Twenty ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars. He is Entitled to Clothing pay from the 31st
day of July 1862 to the time of Discharge
