I have the honor to receive your
Forms which have been furnished by the
2^d Comptroller, for preparing your accounts
in the Indian Department, for settlement
at this office.

Such Indian Agents as are under
your superintendance will of course be
supplied by you with the necessary forms
and instructions for stating their accounts
for your inspection and approval.

When annuities are paid in merchandise,
it will be necessary to designate the
tribe or Nation for whom intended, and
the year, and in the case of presents,
the names and nation of those receiving
them had better be given.

Your accounts are to be rendered year-
ly.
