Sir:

I transmit herewith a blank form for reporting all judgments in your Court in cases arising under the Internal Revenue laws—the collections thereon, and the disposition made of the same as required by the Circular issued to Marshals and Clerks from this Office dated March 20, 1866. The object is, to obtain specific information, in detail, of the result of all cases of this class,—to enable the Department to see that the proceeds thereof have been disposed of according to the requirements of law. It is not intended to supersede the Term report, of all cases in your district, required by law and the general instructions for your government on that subject, a copy of which has been sent you.
