Bruffel personally came before me Edward McDonald
a justice of the peace within and for said
County and acknowledging them selves to owe
the united States of America the sum of
one hundred ⁹⁰ dollars to be levied of their goods and
chattles Lands and tenements on the following
Conditions to it that is if the said William
Hix & Sharloty Pilburn shall be and
appear at the Circuit Court on the first
day of the next term thereof to be holden
for the County aforesaid on the second Monday
of may next at Davidsonville and then
and there answer an indement for
fornication and not depart the Court
with out leave there of then this
recognesance to void other wise remain in
full force and effect taken and
acknowledge before me the day and
year above written Edward McDonald
a justice of the peace
