respectively acknowledge owing to one and be  
indebted the United States of America in the  
sum Five Hundred dollars each to be borne of  
two respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements  
to be void upon Condition that the said Charles B  
Pettigrew, Hugh L Pettigrew and William J Mount  
shall each respectively write and truly make his personal  
appearance before the Judge of the District Court  
of the United States for the Western District of Arkansas  
at a Court to be begun and held in said District at  
the Court House in the City of New Berlin in the County  
of Crawford in said District on the second Monday  
in November next at 1857, it being the first day of  
said term then and then to testify and the truth  
to speak in behalf of the United States of America  
and that they will not depart said land without  
leave thereof
