Biographical/Historical Note

Calvin Comins Bliss (1823-1891) was a farmer and businessman who lived in Helena, Arkansas, from about 1853 until the arrival of United States troops during the Civil War in August 1862. In September, he was commissioned in the Arkansas Infantry Volunteers. He was mustered out January 1863. He edited the Republican paper, *The Unconditional Union*, in Little Rock during 1864 and 1865. In 1864, he became lieutenant governor of Arkansas. After the war, he acquired considerable property throughout the state. Bliss is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Little Rock, Arkansas.
