On this 7th day of March, personally came and appeared before me, Wm. J. Kelly, Clerk of the Pike Circuit Court, W. C. Hale, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says, that he was 49 years of age on the 8th day of January, last (1865), according to the record of his age, furnished him by his parents; and that he verily believes that said record is true: So help him God.
