Dear Fred:

I have received your letter in reference to the Japanese Center at Rowher.

You probably know my position in reference to these centers. I have consistently refused to permit the Japanese to accept outside employment and I did not know that outside employees were working in the Center. This should not be permitted, but the only thing I can do is to call it to the Attention of Mr. J. B. Whitaker, State Director of the War Relocation Project. These people are under Federal Supervision and while I have no authority over them, I have found Mr. Whitaker cooperative in endeavoring to correct the various situations about which complaints are made.
