TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME--GREETING:

This is to Certify, That at an Election held in the State and County aforesaid on the 11th First day of September, A. D. 1874, ~~John Lewis~~ Burrell Walker was elected Constable, for the Township of Silver Lake in the County and State aforesaid, as appears from the official returns made by the Supervisors of Election for the County of Desha.

Now, Therefore, M. B. Peterson Judge of the County Court of Desha County, do hereby, in accordance with the authority vested in me by the Constitution of said State issue to the said ~~John Lewis~~ Burrell Walker this Certificate of Election, authorizing and empowering him to perform all and singular the duties incumbent upon him as said Constable in Silver Lake Township in and for the County aforesaid, according to law and the trust imposed in him for and during the time as prescribed by law.

In Testimony Whereof, I have set my hand and caused the seal of said Court to be affixed at Walam, Arkansas, on this 12th day of

12th November, A. D. 1874
