Biographical/Historical Note

Lucian Roberts Warner was born March 5, 1891, to Richard and Minerva Roberts Warner. He joined the US Army in 1918, then went to the Hodges Pharmacy School in Little Rock where he graduated as a registered pharmacist in 1925.

In 1923, Lucian married Margaret Post and together they had three daughters: Martha Ann Metrailler, Lucia Warner Allen, and Peggy Warner. He spent his life in the Walnut Ridge/Hoxie area, where he served on the Hoxie school board for twenty years and ran Cooper Drugstore for 12 years.

Lucian Warner died in August of 1986 at the age of 95.
