### NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,

THAT, By virtue of an Election Proclamation, issued by W. R. MILLER, Governor of the State of Arkansas, on the 4th day of October, 1880, and directed to the undersigned, as Sheriff of Prairie County, and in pursuance of the Statute in such cases made and provided;

### A Special Election

Will be held on the 22d day of October, A.D., 1880,

AT DES ARC, IN WHITE RIVER TOWNSHIP,  
AND COOK'S SCHOOL HOUSE IN ROCKROE TOWNSHIP,  
In PRAIRIE COUNTY, ARKANSAS,

FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING

**One Justice of the Peace**

In and for each of said Townships, to fill the vacancy occurring by failure to elect more than one Justice of the Peace at the last General Election.

Given under my hand this, the 8th day of October, 1880.
