Sir,

The Secretary of War directs that you transmit all your returns, for settlement of your quarterly accounts, to him, writing on the envelope, "Indian Affairs". The object, is to pass, first, (in this office) upon the contingent disbursements, and also, to transfer the statements, to Books, to be opened in this office, for the purpose; and then to transmit them, to the 2<sup>nd</sup>. Auditor.

It is further directed that particular attention be paid, in making up your accounts so as for them to reach here, as soon after the close of each quarter, as possible.
