Biographical/Historical Note:

Lola Alice Dunnivant was born October 27, 1900, in Des Arc, Arkansas. She was the daughter of James U. Dunnivant and Helen May Johnson Dunnivant. James U. Dunnivant was born about 1862 and died March 2, 1934. Helen May Johnson was born about 1872 and died in 1947.

Lola Dunnivant received her B.A. at Hendrix College in Conway, Arkansas; her B.S. in Library Science at Louisiana State University in 1951, and her Masters in Library Science at the University of Michigan in 1955. She was the school librarian at Little Rock Central High School during the integration crisis of 1957 and wrote an eye-witness account of her experience during that time. She died in February of 1980.

Scope and Contents:

This collection contains Lola Dunnivant's typed and handwritten account of the Little Rock, Arkansas Central High School integration crisis of 1957. Also included are land records of the Dunnivant family in Prairie County, Arkansas, legal documents, bank statements, bills, tax records, college degrees, other writings by Lola Dunnivant, correspondence, teaching materials when she was a teacher and librarian, and photographs.
