STATE OF ARKANSAS

To All to Whom These Presents Shall Come-Greeting:

Know Ye, That Whereas, It appears that
Orval E. Fabus
was duly elected

GOVERNOR

*of the State of Arkansas, at an election held in
said State, on the second day of November 1954.*

*Therefore, I, Francis Cherry, Governor of the State of
Arkansas, in the name and by the authority of the people of the
State of Arkansas, vested in me by the Constitution and laws
of said State, do hereby Commission him*

GOVERNOR

*He is, therefore, hereby authorized to do and
perform all and singular the duties incumbent upon
him in and for the State of Arkansas, according
to law and the trust reposed in him for and during
the term prescribed by the laws of the State.*

*In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my
hand and caused the Great Seal
of the State of Arkansas to be
affixed at Little Rock, this the
first day of January, in the
Year of Our Lord, One Thousand
Nine Hundred and Fifty Five.*
