Sir By the last Southern mail I received a letter from Mr John Spurr stating that he would accept the appointment of Justice of the peace. For him I can say that I believe he is as competent as any man living in the Township in which he resides, and I am satisfied it is the wish of many of his neighbours that he should be appointed to that office.

I therefore am induced to request you to appoint him to that office. - For Missouri Township Clark County -
