Know all Men by these Presents:

That we, *John O. Cobb and Calvin J. Hawks*
~~as principal, and~~ *J. Hawks as principals*
~~as sureties~~, acknowledge ourselves jointly and severally to owe and be indebted unto the United States of America, in the sum of *Three Hundred* dollars, to be levied of our goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the said United States, if default shall be made in the condition following, to-wit:

Whereas, ~~the said~~ *John Wickes*
has been brought before JAMES O. CHURCHILL, a United States Commissioner for the Western District of Arkansas, to answer to the charge of *Larceny*

and upon examination had, it appearing to said Commissioner that the offence with which he was charged had been committed, and that there was probable cause to believe ~~him~~ *him* guilty thereof, the Commissioner ordered said *John O. Cobb and Calvin J. Hawks* to find sufficient bail in the sum of *Three Hundred* dollars for ~~their~~ *their* appearance at a District Court of the United States for the Western District of Arkansas, to be holden on the *5th* day of *May* A. D. 1871, at the U. S. Court Room in the city of Van Buren, in said District, to answer what may ~~arise in said case~~ *arise in said case*; and that in default of finding such bail stand committed ~~for trial~~.

Now, Therefore, The condition of this Recognizance is such, that if the said *John O. Cobb and Calvin J. Hawks* shall personally appear at the said Court on the first day of the next *May* Term thereof, at the U. S. Court Room in the city of Van Buren, at 10 o'clock A. M., and then and there ~~answer in such matters and things as shall be objected against~~ *answer in such matters and things as shall be objected against* and abide the orders of the Court, and not depart the said Court without leave, then this Recognizance to be void, otherwise to be in full force and virtue.
