Jerome Medical Head To Speak Here Sunday Night

Dr. Douglas Collier, new head of the hospital at the Jerome WRA Center, will give an illustrated lecture on Modern Missions in Thailand at the Presbyterian Church on Sunday night at 7:30 P. M.

Dr. Collier was a medical missionary of the Northern Presbyterian Church in Thailand (Siam) for 16 years before being forced to leave by the Japanese invasion. Some of the results of his special research in leprosy and other diseases of the Far East will be shown in moving pictures as a part of his lecture. He will also speak of the Japanese occupation of that country.
