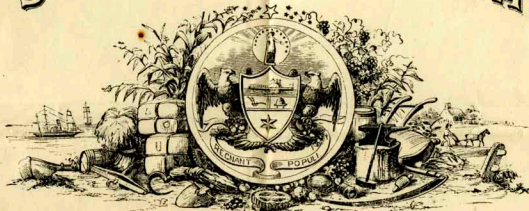

Under and by virtue of an Ordinance State of Arkansas, adopted and passed "ARKANSAS WAR BOND." of the Convention of the People of the on the 28th day of May, A. D. 1861.

Know all Men by these Presents, That the State of Arkansas, five years from the first day of July, 1861, promises to pay to J. H. Snowden or bearer, the sum of Three Hundred Dollars in specie, with interest at the rate of Eight per centum per annum from date, to be paid semi-annually in specie, on the first days of January and July, in each Year, at the Treasury of the State of Arkansas, and is "receivable, at par, in payment of debts due to the Bank of the State of Arkansas, and Real Estate Bank of the State of Arkansas, in payment for any debt due to the State, either in her own right or as Trustee; in payment for the purchase of any lands belonging to the State, and in payment of State revenue." "The faith of the State of Arkansas, and all the public lands thereof, are" "pledged for the payment and redemption of" this and other like Bonds.

In Testimony Whereof, The Treasurer of the State of Arkansas has herunto set his name and affixed his official seal, and the Auditor of Public Accounts has counter signed the same, this the 8th day of July, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty one.
