INTRODUCING SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS  
INTO THE INDIAN COUNTRY.

The Grand Jurors of the United States of America, duly selected, empaneled, sworn and charged to inquire in and for the body of the Western District of Arkansas, upon their oath present: that heretofore, to-wit: on the *1* day of *April* A. D., 189*3* at the *Cherokee* Nation, in the Indian Country, in the Western District of Arkansas, aforesaid, one

then and there did unlawfully introduce into the Indian Country, in said District, spirituous liquors, to-wit: *all* gallon of whiskey; contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the United States of America.
