A, Proclamation.

By the Governor.

Whereas, information having been given to me, that
Moses R. Guthrie, stands indicted in the Circuit
Court in the County of Monroe in this State, for the mur-
-der of John B. Druggs; And WHEREAS, fur-
-ther information has been given, that the said Moses
R. Guthrie is now a Refugee from Justice —

Therefore,
I, James S. Conway, Governor of the State of
Arkansas, to the end that said Murderer be brought
to justice, and the Laws faithfully executed, and by
the Authority in me vested by the Constitution and
Laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby offer a Re-
-ward of One thousand and Fifty dollars, for the
apprehension and delivery of the said Moses R. Guth-
-rie, to the Sheriff of Monroe County in this State. And
all officers, civil and military, are enjoined to spare
no pains to secure and bring to Justice said Murderer.

the 28th day of April A.D. 1837.
