WARRANT dated Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> 1873, Served by W. R. Walker on John Grass and Trade Livery at Saline District Prison Station, Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> 1873

10 days endeavoring to arrest, from Sept 9<sup>th</sup> to Sept 24<sup>th</sup> inclusive

Mileage on writ 17.5 miles, at 6 cents per mile

Actual expenses 21 days feeding 2 prisoners from Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> to Oct 15<sup>th</sup> inclusive

Mileage returning 2 prisoner guard and deputy 15.0 miles each 30.0 miles at 10 cts. per mile
