 June 29th 1841

To the Auditor Genl
 of the State of Arkansas

Dear Sir

I own the Patents of two
 tracts of Land in Arkansas viz The 1st 1/2^{gr} of
 Sec 30 in Township 9 North in Range 5 West in
 the tract appropriated for Mellaloy Donator in the
 Territory of Arkansas granted to John Marley son and
 only heir at law of John Marley dec^d
 in Pursuance of Mandat Numbered 25,781
 The patent dated 10th August 1825

The other The 1/2^{gr} of Sec 34 of Township 4 South in
 Range 5 West granted to James Woodward only heir
 at Law of John Woodward or Woodward Junior
 to his Mandat Numbered 26,220
 The patent dated 3rd day of November 1829
 The Land being regularly conveyed to me for a
 valuable consideration.

Please to inform me whether the above lands are
 owned by the state for taxes and the amount
 required to redeem them and what kind of
 money will be taken - Please answer me
 soon and Obliged Yours & George W. Horned
