Educating Japanese Up To The WRA

Responsibility for educating children of Japanese families relocated in two southeast Arkansas centers will be assumed by the War Relocation Authority, state Director E. B. Whitaker notified the state Education Department.

Schools to be established in the Chicot and Desha county centers will conform to the same standards as other institutions in Arkansas, Mr. Whitaker said. Japanese teachers will be selected and paid with WRA funds. State and local school districts will not be asked to aid in the program except in an advisory capacity.
