Know all men by these presents, That the State of Arkansas acknowledges to be indebted to the **REAL ESTATE BANK** of the State of **ARKANSAS**, in the sum of **ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS**, which sum the said State of Arkansas promises to pay, in current money of the United States, to the order of the President, Directors and Company of said Bank, on the **thirteenth day of January**, one thousand eight hundred and **fiftyone**, with interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable half-yearly, at the place named in the endorsement hereto, on the first day of January and July, of each year, until the payment of said principal.

In Testimony whereof, the Governor of the State of Arkansas has signed, and the Treasurer of the State has countersigned, these presents, and caused the seal of the State to be fixed thereto, at **LITTLE ROCK**, this *13th* day of *January* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *fortyone*.
