Dear Sir

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter accompanying a Resolution of the Senate adopted 5th Inst. requiring the Committee on Banks, to obtain from the Cashiers of the State Bank of Arkansas & its Branches, an abstract of the liabilities of all the officers, & those that have been officers of said Bank & Branches, both as principals & Security, also the amount of said liabilities that now remain unrenewed or protested —
