Fort Wayne was abandones and the new position, since called but Scott, taken (better dividing the distance from Port Sibson to Fort Toroson on great delikeration founded on satisfactory reports from the principal officers acquainted with those frontiers. Nothing has since occurred to change the decision in favor of the new location, or to Show that the old one ought to be re-occupies.
