The Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) is an agency under the Department of Arkansas Heritage. Its mission focuses on documenting, registering, and preserving places, landmarks, and structures that encompass historical and cultural significance for the state of Arkansas and its residents.

Scope and Contents

This collection is comprised of various AHPP record groups from multiple state records transfers.
