Dear Sir,

At Smiths Sale for Montpelier County for Taxes of
New Grants Lands 25th Feb'y 1847 there was transferred to the
State Treasury Tracts of land belonging to E. J. Jewett -
Major Aids, the funds of Mr. Jewett is here and wishes to learn
the situation of the business - Please write me what amount
is due on these Lands and what amt must be paid into
the State Treasury: If Aids & State Tax for Land Tax can
be paid him at end of the draft of the Treasurer of our
County for Tax. in^o by State Tax for our County will be
returned - I wish the Aids to amount in Mr. Jewett again -
Please write me on the subject by return mail.
