when the day of reckoning does come the
greater it will be) Endors you will find
my account against the State for the 1st
quarter Salary due me for 1847 (\$25⁰⁰) and
receipt - = you will confer on me a special
favor if you endorse me my scrip on the 1st day
of April as the mail leaves Little Rock on
that night for the west & I will then be
enabled to get it before I go on the
Northern circuit - And by doing this you
will confer on me a special favor which
I will be proud to reciprocate at any
time
