Saline County
May, 24th 1845.

My Dear Sir,

I wish you would visit me by the morning stage and inform me, how many square miles there are in the present limits of Saline County.

This information I have not the means of attaining, as I have no maps with the survey, nor any with the county lines.

My conception of the calculation, is that any new county may be established with less than nine hundred square miles, provided it had the requisite population, what say you.

A division of the county is agitated, wherefore the information which for is important to me & wish to avail myself of the first opportunity that presents itself, to illustrate the subject before my honorable constituents.

Next Saturday is a day of meeting at Barton, so will see, the importance to me, of writing forthwith.
