Waynesboro, 11th April 1848

M^r E. N. Conway

Dear Sir I see your name on one of the papers from the District of C. Washington as the Auditor of Arkansas, I had also written you a letter, say Six Months ago, in reference to a quarter section of Land, lying on the Neigh borhood of Little Rock, & since to the present I have received no answer, it is the South east quarter of Section thirty two, of Township three North, of the base line, in Range twelve west of the fifth principal meridian, containing One hundred and Sixty Acres, I have the patent of May 1810 that was granted by J. D. Adams to Frederick Warren son of Wm Warren Senr, on the 23rd May 1844 M^r Jacob Barnett through an agent paid all the taxes and other expenses that that had accrued a gainst said Land, and I have now in my possession the deed you made to said J. Barnett the 22nd May 1844, you will confer a favour if you will be so kind as to inform me the situation the Land is in now, and what tax may be due on the same, and whether the Land is worth any thing, if has cost me forty high, so soon as I can ascertain I will remit the amount of money that will pay the taxes &c - I would like if you couldnt attend to it your self to recommend some one that would
