Three Soldiers From Rohwer Center Arrested For Car Theft

Three soldiers attached to the Jerome-Rohwer Military Police were taken in custody by Desha County officers this week and turned over to Military Police authorities at the Rohwer Center charged with stealing a car at Pine Bluff Sunday night.

The three men said to be G. A. Trudeau, M. Maltelli and C. A. Dugas are charged with stealing the automobile about 9:30 p.m. Sunday at Pine Bluff and driving to a point near Dumas where it was abandoned. Desha County officers called by Pine Bluff authorities about the theft, took the men in custody between Rohwer and Kelso.
