Trouble Rumor Is Unfounded

The rumor that trouble was expected from a number of Japanese being sent from the Center at Rohwer to the Tule Lake Relocation Center for Disloyal Orientals is unfounded, according to Varnell Lee, city marshal.

Mr. Lee went on to say that the only incident he knows of which might have started a rumor was the taking into custody Saturday afternoon of an aged and mentally unbalanced Japanese man who had wandered away from the camp Friday and spent the night in McGehee at a local hotel.

No difficulty was encountered in the matter, Mr. Lee said, and the man is now in a mental hospital.
