Dear Sir

A Mr. Joseph Emerson  
Sr. called at my office a few days since  
showed me a Land Warrant given  
by the late Gen. Jackson when Presi-  
dent in the year 1832, to Rufus L.  
Bonney and the other heirs of Lewis  
Bonney late a Private in Captain  
Dolan's Company of the Thirty-third  
Regiment United States Infantry and to  
his heirs, a certain Tract of Land  
containing One hundred and sixty acres  
being the South east quarter of Section Six  
of Township Six South in Range Four  
West in the Tract appropriated for Military  
Bonnet's, (act passed on and since the 6<sup>th</sup>  
of May 1812) in the Territory (now State) of  
Arkansas.

I wish to ascertain where the  
above described land can be found. I  
have learned (perhaps not correctly) that  
it is in the South west part of your  
north
