Scarsboro April the 16 1850

To your excellency Dear Sir they was
a friend Satid to me yesterday that Colonel
Cambel had wrote to you concerning
my acts and character and had given a
bad account of it to you and the cause is becuz
I have opposed his cours as a political man
I did not belong to the same party that he did
and he has concluded to through a sleaz
on me from from home fr he moud he
cant do it at home for he noows that
I have bin living hear for beten than
14 years and what biznes I have ~~bin~~ don
for the county I have settid strale and
paid evry cent I owed it but they is
two party hear and my fendz concluded
to have me appointed shearaff they was a
petition got up and put in the post
ofice with the notifikation of the shuff
re his resig nation and it was put in
the post oppel by the Clark at bel'nan
I want you if you please to send me
acopy of the letter Colonel Cambel
wrote to your excellency you are not
acquainted with me nor me with you
only comiter I mo you I hope
for beten acquaintance with you
