Dear Sir

Your communication of the 2<sup>nd</sup> inst. has just been received, in reply I have to state that in accordance with the act approved 29<sup>th</sup> Dec. 1848, Section 6 I have issued a writ of election to fill the vacancy in the office of County Judge of your County, and consequently until said election is held, and the person elected qualified you will have no County Judge -

You wish to know "to whom you are to pay the County revenue or Treasurer of the County" by referring to the Digest of the Statutes of Arkansas - Chapter 138, Section 15 & 24 inclusive you will find that you are to pay <sup>out</sup> the money except by order of the County Court, hence you can pay out none until there is a County Judge elected to hold the Courts.
