Now all men by these presents
 that I Samuell I Mason as principal and
 Daniel Jeffery and I I Lewis
 as his securities are here and firmly bound
 unto the State of Arkansas in the sum of
 of three thousand dollars & over and lawful
 money of the United States the payment of
 which will and truly to be made within
 ourselves and our legal representatives jointly
 by these presents with our hands and seals
 this November the 9th A.D. 1850

The condition of the above obligation
 is such that whereas the above bounden Samuel
 was on the 5th day of August A.D. 1850 duly
 elected Sheriff of said county by which
 he is by law made collector of said county

Now if the said Samuel
 I Mason shall well truly and faithfully
 discharge all the duties incumbent
 upon him as such collector according
 to law and the List-kept used in him
 and pay over all sums of money that
 may come to his hands as such collector
 then this obligation to be void otherwise
 to remain in full force and effect
