Received, Fort Smith, Arkansas, Dec. 4th 1874

From G. H. McIntosh, Deputy U. S. Marshal for the Western District of Arkansas, the sum of Twenty five $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars

in full of my wages for services as Guard rendered in the arrest and bringing One Able

from Stone wall, Ark to Fort Smith Ark charged with Larceny in the Indian

country, from Nov 19 to Nov 24, 1874, both days inclusive, at the rate of \$2.00 per diem, 12.00

and actual expenses of subsistence while en route, 13.50

Total, \$ 25.50
