I have the honor to inform
you, that this office will by
the 1st of Sept next, expire
the title of Arkansas, to give
rise to "additional proof-
ing" in my letter of the
1st May last touching certain
land bids. — final ac-
-tion upon which, has been
for "New Line Post" suspended,
which will proof might
be filed &c.

After which period
you will show a like notice,
that should the state, through
the proper authorities, fail
in addressing such testimony,
the action of this office will be
over the matter final, and
the lands referred to, by me
reported to the Commissioner of the
General Land office, at ^{of them} ~~the~~ ~~office~~.
