Sir

I hope you will excuse the liberty
of a direct communication in an almost stranger
when I might request some one of my relations to
see you, but I dislike the thought of troubling them
in a matter without interest for them -

I enclose you the letter of Mr Banks
which explains itself - & by leave to add it would
particular gratify me if you could give him the
desired appointment - I would congratulate you
Sir, upon your nomination but for its having so
long seemed a fixed fact that you would receive
it - I share the feelings of the Democracy at the
prospect of your reelection -
