We the undersigned would most respectfully petition that Olin Gray Randall be appointed a Commissioner of the State of Arkansas within and for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Mr Randall within the past six months has been appointed a Commissioner of all the New England States along New York Pennsylvania Ohio Indiana Virginia Iowa and other Southern and Western States. Mr Randall is a Notary Public and of considerable importance that were a Commissioner of the States. Mr Randall's position as an intelligent upright citizen and influential business man is such as to guarantee that the duties of this office will be well performed and its character and dignity fully sustained.
