Biographical/Historical Note

The Norfolk Methodist Church, Methodist Episcopal South, was organized in 1893. At one time Norfolk community was known as Liberty and was part of Izard County, Arkansas. Norfolk became a part of Baxter County in 1873. The town was incorporated in 1906 after the railroad arrived. The church register was presented to the Norfolk Historical Society by Billy G. Staggs, as a memorial to his grandfather, Gideon Erastus Brown Cunningham, a member of Norfolk Methodist Church, and Staggs' mother, Ruth Cunningham Staggs.

This register contains records of marriages, infant baptisms, and membership rosters, 1893-1949.
