Sevier County Oct 3<sup>d</sup> 1869

Sir;

There is a little fellow they call Little Tom Kings who I am informed stands indicted in Maine county for the murder of one Bart Green. It is supposed he is on the Cadron near the sulphur Springs in Conway County. He is a small chunky man - about five feet one or two inches high weighs about 125 or 130 pounds sandy or fair hair, and fair complexion and looks rather on the boyish side - is a wicked vulgar obscene mech, and has all the cunning of the most artful scoundrel

Ascertain where he is - and this you must do by hearing others talk without asking direct questions yourself - And when you have ascertained arrest him at all hazards - Iron him securely, and proceed with him to Yellville - There to await further orders - If you arrest Little Tom, you had better tie the Kings, as they may become alarmed and leave - Suffer no one to insult or molest the prisoners in any way
