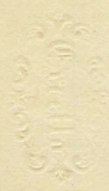

Having been assigned the Command of the Counties of *Craighead and Green*, I desire the co-operation of all good citizens in both counties "to assist in the enforcement of Law" and the maintainance of the *proper authority*. You are also required to deliver to these *Headquarters* all arms and ammunition in your possession, or *volunteer your services* to use them in this command. And all persons caught bearing ARMS after this date, in this DISTRICT, without the proper *authority* from these *Headquarters*, will be considered as OUTLAWS and treated as such.

No. 1

Having been assigned the Command of the Counties of
Crawford and Drew, I desire the co-operation of all good citi-
zens in both counties "to assist in the enforcement of Law" and
the maintenance of the proper authority. You are also required
to deliver to these Headquarters all arms and ammunition in your
possession, or to report your services to use them in this command.
And all persons caught bearing arms after this date, in this
District, without the proper authority from these Headquarters,
will be considered as outlaws and treated as such.
