In regard to your request
 of wanting to know the number
 of disfranchised in my County
 I have been very neglectful
 in sending up the number as I
 am just in receipt of your letter
 of date Nov 20th I will forward
 to your office the number as
 I have been put to some considerable
 before I could get the number
 I am now prepared to comply with
 your request the number who appear
 is seventy leaving as near as I can
 ascertain three hundred and seventy five
 who did not appear total 445 disfranchised
 in the County which if I would do this
 in your request I think that you would try
 to have me something paid for my
 trouble now forwarding according to
 your request leaving this with you for
 remuneration to your humble servant
